TO THE EDITOR:

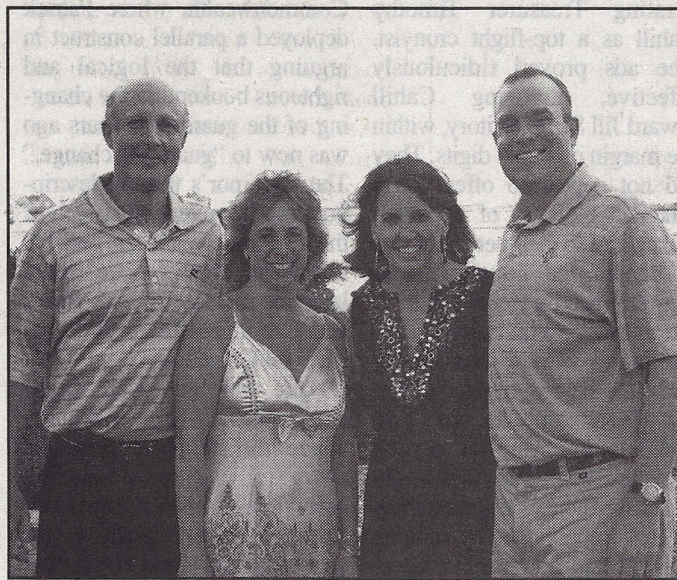
